Théodule Augustin Ribot (1823-1891) (attributed to): "Boats near the shore", ink and brush drawing 11 X 25 cm on paper washed with a pink gradient, mounted by a neutral pH mat in a reverse slope light oak frame 43 X 54 cm. An annotation from the previous owner appeared on the back of the old mount: "Marie-José S. 11 1993 Purchased in Paris Louvre des Antiquaires". This extraordinary artist was one of my favorites from the beginning because I had bought an old book on him and we have a wonderful one in Pau "The Good Samaritan", fortunately enriched with his preparatory study for about fifteen years, and yet, I did not know these drawings bordering on abstraction or certain Far Eastern artists, all suggestion, letting us guess sailboats near the coast during low tide which reveals bouchots...
