Description

Library pedestal table or living room table in tea table format, tilting cabaret top, in solid speckled mahogany (luxury mahogany). The fluted shaft rests on a tripod base with skate feet. Louis XVI period, late 18th century. Canabas stamp and JME jurande hallmark. Joseph Gengenbach known as Canabas (1715-1797) master in 1766: both cabinetmaker and carpenter, he used both veneer and solid wood, mainly mahogany. Canabas then established himself as a specialist in fancy, practical and often newly designed furniture. He thus produced a large number of small and carefully crafted pieces of furniture during his career. His style is very particular: he uses mahogany wood of a rare quality, a remarkable color, a very tight grain and he stands out in the perfection of their cabinetmaking.
