Produced by the Japanese company Tendo Mokko in the 1960s, this sideboard is made of solid teak and teak veneer with a warm, even grain. It opens with two teak side doors and two smoked glass sliding doors, revealing a modular interior space with adjustable shelves. The structure rests on a tubular metal base, giving the whole a visual lightness and modernity that interacts with the natural richness of the wood.
