Pierre Thiriot (1904-1991) An artist from Lorraine (France), he distinguished himself as a decorative painter, animal painter and illustrator, notably for musical and theatrical revues. He worked for emblematic places such as the Moulin Rouge, the Folies Bergères and the Casino de Paris, where he designed sets and costumes. Thiriot is particularly known for his illustrations of La Fontaine's Fables, produced in a book printed in only 25 copies by the Gonin brothers, whose publication was interrupted by the war. Large painting on canvas by Pierre Thiriot representing 3 roosters and 2 hens. Very colorful painting in a pine-type wooden frame. Information and other photos on request.
