Pair of brass candlesticks, Empire period, probably for Jean-Louis-Ébénézer Reynier (1771-1814). The circular bases have friezes of palmettes, pearl threads and gadroons, the faceted shafts have gadrooned rings, pearl threads and laurel friezes, the bobeches have friezes of palmettes, gadroons and pearls. One of the undersides is inscribed "REYNIER", which may correspond to Count Jean-Louis-Ébénézer Reynier (1771-1814), general of the Empire. ·
