Two immaculate horses, harnessed in green and gold, draw an imperial carriage in shades of purple and gilt, richly adorned with floral garlands and rococo moldings. Inside, a noble couple shares a tender moment: the lady, dressed in a pink lace gown, gently leans on her companion's shoulder, his
