Description

Georges Nowak (1884-1956) Clock - French work circa 1905 This Art Nouveau clock gracefully embodies the organic and floral aesthetic of the early twentieth century. Crafted from solid carved and pierced mahogany, it unfolds in supple, elongated lines that evoke the stem of a stylized flower. The finely chased gilt bronze ornaments bloom into delicate floral motifs, while the mother-of-pearl marquetry adds subtle iridescent highlights, enhancing the refinement of the whole piece. The dial, with its handwritten numerals characteristic of the style, integrates harmoniously with the fluid structure of the body, giving the work a rare sculptural unity. A testament to the craftsmanship of French artisans of the period, this creation by Georges Nowak combines decorative elegance with technical
