Very beautiful seal or stamp from the 19th century, the handle in ivory, the head bearing the silver seal; hallmarked with a boar's head. A beautiful writing object very nicely crafted, both in terms of the ivory and the head of the silver seal in rocaille or baroque style; the latter has a beautiful patina that I did not want to "touch". The seal itself is numbered, I have inserted a fairly precise photo by reversing the image so that you can read the initials. If you have any questions, we are at your disposal. Additional information: Ivory specimen of Elephantidae spp (I / A) pre-agreement, prior to June 1, 1947 in accordance with CE Regulation 338/97 of 12/09/1996 art.2-Wmc. For an exit from the EU, a CITES re-export will be necessary, this being the responsibility of the future purchaser. The
