Elegant Meissen porcelain cup and saucer, entirely hand-painted with genre scenes and river landscapes featuring figures, architecture, and boats, inspired by early 18th-century Dutch taste. The cup has gilt interior and base, ornate gilt handle, and a finely outlined rim. The saucer features a central figurative reserve on a lustrous gilt ground. Underglaze blue crossed swords mark beneath the base, typical of the Royal Meissen manufactory (period of Augustus the Strong). Cup height: 7 cm Saucer diameter: 13.5 cm Excellent condition, minor wear to the gilding. A charming and early example of Meissen's refined production from the first decades of the 18th century.
