Each rooster in full attack, wings spread, body twisting and finely chiseled plumage. This pair of roosters is distinguished by the tension of the movement and the precision of the modeling. The surfaces alternate polished and chiseled to better emphasize the light on the plumage. The balance between vigor and elegance perfectly embodies the post-war animal style, between decorative tradition and formal modernity. Work of great virtuosity, typical of the Maison Eschwege, Parisian goldsmith renowned in the post-war period for its animal sculptures with expressive naturalism.
