The marriage of polished silver and dark wood creates a refined contrast characteristic of the modernist aesthetic of the 20th century. This cup illustrates the work of high-quality manufacturing workshops. It testifies to Puiforcat's taste for creations combining sobriety of forms and nobility of materials.
