Description

Large matched pair of Royal Worcester figures in the blush ivory palette, modelled by James Hadley. Naturalistic rockwork bases, soft flesh tones and restrained gilding; heights approx. 45.5 cm and 44 cm, an uncommon large display size for Worcester. Marks: printed crowned roundel "Royal Worcester England"; Rd No 67080 (design registered 1887); impressed/incised "Hadley" signatures; Worcester dot-device dates reading 1892 and 1893 for the respective figures. Registration number indicates design protection only. Hadley (1837-1903), Worcester's leading designer 1866-1895, created the factory's most celebrated figure series and established the blush ivory aesthetic. Collecting note: large-format, correctly dated pairs with intact Hadley signatures are notably scarce and
