Circa 1920 Dimensions: Height 36 cm Width 44 cm Depth 30 cm Sculpted in a white marble of great finesse, this work by Leilio Landucci captures a moment of tender complicity between two young children, seated on a rock, absorbed in the innocent play of a bird's nest placed beside them. The subtle realism of the childish flesh, the delicate treatment of the curls and gestures, as well as the softness of the expressions give the scene a touching and timeless poetry. Landucci, a sculptor active at the beginning of the 20th century, is part of the neoclassical tradition while integrating a naturalist sensibility. His art celebrates the purity of childhood and the beauty of the present moment, through a balanced and graceful

composition. The contrast between the polished surface of the bodies and the rough texture of the base accentuates the naturalness of the scene.

This work embodies both the sculptor's technical virtuosity and his ability to convey a simple and universal emotion. It is in line with the idealized representations of childhood that were highly prized in early 20th-century European art.
