These SK640 armchairs were designed by Pierre Guariche for the French manufacturer Steiner in the early 1950s. They perfectly represent post-war French modernist design with their elegant wooden frames, sculpted armrests and clean lines characteristic of the style of Guariche, one of the most influential French designers of this period. Pierre Guariche's creations are particularly sought after by collectors and lovers of mid-20th century French design. The SK640 model is appreciated for its balance between aesthetics and comfort, as well as for its important place in the history of French design.
