A student of Jean-François Portaels, Hermans followed the tradition of poetic realism, influenced by the Flemish masters and the great European portraitists. He is particularly renowned for the gentleness of his female portraits, always imbued with sensitivity, restraint, and elegance. The painting presented here depicts a young girl with flowing hair, wearing a simple white dress and a cross pendant. The calm, almost meditative expression of the model, as well as the delicate treatment of skin tones and hair, perfectly illustrate the art of
