Produced by Knoll, these iconic chairs perfectly embody the ideals of the Bauhaus--where form follows function with absolute elegance. This iconic set is distinguished by the single-piece chromed steel frame, which gives the armchairs a light, floating appearance while ensuring structural strength and comfort, and by the Camel leather upholstery (in very good condition), which brings a bold, contemporary touch to the minimalist, timeless silhouette. The flat bar base and upholstered arms demonstrate Mies's mastery of modern materials and harmonious proportions. Still as contemporary as when they were first created, these armchairs make a sophisticated addition to
