(1861-1934) began as a comic actor in the theater
in 1879 and we have here a very beautiful portrait
of the young actor, full-length and in costume. It
is precisely dated June 23, 1879, before the actor
became famous as a theater director in the late
19th and early 20th centuries. It was he who
created the "Baret tours", tours of shows which
allowed the theatre to be exported throughout
