Dimensions: Length 68 cm. Height 49.8 cm. Dimensions with frame: Length 86.2 cm. Height 67.4 cm. Auguste Cammissar (1873-1962) is a French artist of international stature born in Strasbourg. The son of a glassmaker, trained at the Karlsruhe Academy, he perfected his skills in Munich, Vienna and Strasbourg, and was a full professor at the School of Decorative Arts in this city from 1896 to 1940. Among his students were Kamm, Allenbach and Luc Hueber. He studied the technique of opal glass and produced numerous stained glass windows in collaboration with the artist Paul Braunagel (1873-1954).
