Print representing the Vauban tower and the chapel of Rocamadour in Camaret in the Crozon Peninsula. Signed lower right, from the artist's workshop. Micheline Mével-Roussel was a well-known artist in the region but also throughout France. A master engraver, this multidisciplinary artist was also recognized for her talents as a printer. She worked with a large number of Breton artists (Péron, Brayer, etc.) but not only that. She also worked for the posthumous publication of a large box of woodcuts by Mathurin Méheut, a project commissioned by Maryvonne Méheut. She is decorated Chevalier des Arts et des Lettres. 30 cm side for the sheet, 12 cm x 16 cm for the printed part. Sold unframed.
