Superb fine porcelain dinner service by Théodore Haviland Limoges, rare model "L'Oiseau Bleu de Paradis", produced in the first half of the 20th century. The delicate decoration depicts an exotic bird perched on a flowering branch, surrounded by polychrome floral motifs and enhanced with fine gold lines on a cream background. A composition that is both poetic and refined, typical of the emerging Art Deco style. This service includes 73 pieces: dinner plates, soup plates and dessert plates, as well as several matching serving dishes and soup tureens. Each piece demonstrates the exceptional craftsmanship of the Haviland factory, a symbol of elegance and quality in French porcelain.
