This whimsical and highly decorative piece features a finely detailed silver-plated body with textured legs and hinged wings that lift to reveal a deep ruby glass reservoir designed to hold honey. The underside is stamped "Mappin & Webb," "Mappin Plate," "London & Sheffield," and the pattern number W11518, confirming its authenticity and origin. Although produced circa 1960, this piece reflects the refined aesthetic of the Edwardian period and is a testament to Mappin & Webb's heritage of exceptional craftsmanship. Founded in 1775 in Sheffield and expanded in 1862 in partnership with George Webb, Mappin & Webb became a symbol of British luxury and was granted a Royal Warrant as Goldsmith to the Crown. This delightful bee-shaped honey pot is both a functional table
