Dimensions with frame: Length 47.2 cm. Width: 39.5 cm American box frame. Benner Emmanuel-Michel, (1873-1965) known as Many, so that he is not confused with his uncle Emmanuel Benner. He was born in Capri to an Italian mother named Pagano, an island from which he drew great inspiration for his paintings.
