Kazaridana - Decorative display cabinet - Meiji period Japanese Wood species: Various precious woods, possibly paulownia (kiri), zelkova or rosewood. Marquetry: Highly detailed inlaid geometric patterns in different wood tones, typical of Japanese woodworking art, possibly Yosegi-zaiku (????). Hand-carved elements: Geometric patterns, swastika motifs (traditional Buddhist symbol of prosperity), floral elements. Shoe clasps / hardware: Details in bronze or brass. Multi-layered structure: The cabinet is composed of several sections, with alcoves, sliding doors, drawers and cabinets. Open display cabinets: With sliding glass doors and visible storage spaces. Asymmetrical design: Typically Japanese: balance through asymmetry, aesthetic and functional. Decorative roof-shaped top: The
