treatment of color and light. A 20th-century work,  
this unique, signed composition depicts a portrait  
of a woman gazing toward the horizon, bathed in  
an atmosphere that is both mysterious and  
vibrant. The delicately modeled face contrasts  
with the chromatic richness of the surrounding  
tones: deep shades of blue and green highlight the

background, while the blonde hair, enhanced with warm touches of orange and red, immediately catches the eye. The use of hardboard as a support accentuates the density of the pigments and the depth of the contrasts, giving the work a remarkable expressive force. Through its balance between realism and pictorial expression, this female portrait is close to the research of modern painting in Lyon in the 20th century, where the influences of expressionism and a masterful fauvism shine through. This painting constitutes not only a powerful decorative work, but also a historical and artistic testimony to the singular universe of Jean Perret.
