Longitudinal grooved fuse and cast bronze pommel in the style of the 1833 sword. Quillon of the 1831 sword model. Leather scabbard with 2 brass fittings and chape button, used by the National Guard. For the Army it is a trigger guard. Length: 62 cm SF length: 59 cm Blade length: 44.5 cm.
