Trained at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Paris with Gustave Moreau, Fernand Cormon and François Flameng, Vincent Anglade exhibited each year at the Salon des Artistes Français where he received an award in 1903. He quickly established himself as a fashionable society portraitist, renowned for his intimate representations of women which he captured in photographic snapshots where he

excelled at capturing the essence of movement. Considered by the Revue as one of our best pencil artists, he also distinguished himself as an animal painter, driven by his passion for horse and greyhound racing. He regularly appeared at the Paris Horse Show. He also tried his hand at humorous drawing for numerous magazines and signed multiple advertising projects for the brands Peugeot, Bénédictine, and the National Lottery. Our portrait depicts a radiant little girl captured in a moment of wonder, her wide-open eyes expressing joy and confidence. Her baby face is enveloped in a peaked cloche hat typical of the Art Deco period, harmoniously letting her curls escape, while her sketched hand sinks into a cozy muff
