Jules DIDIER (1831-1914) Cows in a green landscape Oil on canvas 46 x 32.5 cm (very good condition) Jules Didier, born on May 26, 1831 in Paris, where he died in the 15th arrondissement on April 23, 1914, is a French painter and lithographer. Jules Didier entered the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris on April 8, 1852 in the studios of Léon Cogniet and Jules Laurens. He won the Prix de Rome in the historical landscape category in 1857 for the painting Jesus and the Samaritan Woman. Jules Didier exhibited at the Paris Salon from 1853 and won medals in 1866 and 1869.
