19th-century artists continued the long tradition of still life painting, and many made it a lifelong study. In the second half of the century, some of the greatest Impressionist painters, such as Monet, Renoir, and Cézanne, made it an integral part of their work, and in the case of Fantin-Latour, it was truly a lifelong study. Many other artists also devoted their artistic careers to still life painting, including Georges Jeannin, Eugène Claude, Madeleine Lemaire, Eugène H. Cauchois, Paul Biva, and Edmond Van Coppenolle. Like his contemporaries, Coppenolle's work was heavily influenced by the Impressionists, often capturing the softness and beauty of his subject with
