centers of chain stitch embroidery. The most characteristic work is seen on old satin and cotton skirts embroidered with the most brilliant silks, with flower sowings and borders of flowers and birds. Many places in Rajputana and Punjab are famous for embroidered bodices. In almost all these works, countless small pieces of mirrored glass are used, forming part of the design and fixed by a circle with a buttonhole stitch. The quantity of glass is sometimes such that the weight of the garment makes it uncomfortable. This type of work is found in Afghanistan, but with a slightly different technique.
