Description

Superb oil on canvas depicting Saint Camillus de Lellis (1550-1614), founder of the Camillians and an emblematic figure of Christian charity. The saint is depicted praying before a crucifix placed on a table covered with a deep red drape, a symbol of sacrifice and faith. The composition highlights the figure's mystical fervor: his gaze turned heavenward, his hands crossed on his chest, testify to intense devotion. The skillfully mastered chiaroscuro gives the scene an intimate and spiritual atmosphere, in the great religious pictorial tradition of the 19th century. The canvas, presented in a period gilded frame, has a beautiful antique patina and demonstrates great finesse of execution. This work, both moving and solemn, is a true religious collector's item, ideal for lovers of sacred art and classical interiors.
