Very beautiful trophy or massacre of deer from the 19th century, dated 1894. 13 or 15 horns I think, three additional small antlers to report (as I am not an expert in the matter I would ask you to look carefully at the photos). This deer was hunted in the old royal forest of Ermenonville. On the front part of the skull of the animal is written in pen: FOREST OF ERMENONVILLE 18942 January Rendez-Vs at the White House Attack at Grimpillot Taken at Molton after 1 hour of hunting Let-run by Cauvain HONORS to the Countess of Longperrier We can easily find the places where this hunt took place, "The White House"; "Le Grimpillot" and "Molton" by consulting documents on the so-called Ermenonville forest. <https://www.parc-oise-paysdefrance.fr/wp->
