Description

This dynamic carriage racing scene at the Krieau racecourse in Vienna was painted in the 1900s and, due to its similarity in style, composition, and period of creation, has been attributed to the renowned Viennese horse painter and illustrator Carl Franz Bauer (1879-1954), who achieved European fame for his paintings of horses, carriages, sports, watercolors, and caricatures. Inscription: Unsigned, with inscription on the lower left giving the horses' names and pedigree and on the lower right the name of the horse's owner, Bes. (Besitzer, English: owner) Harry Godderidge. We discovered online that Harry Godderidge was part-owner of a textile mill in Sankt Pölten from 1903 to 1906. Medium: Oil on board. Antique silver-plated wooden frame.
