Description

Cloisonné vase from the Chinese Republican period (1912-1949). This vase features an elegant baluster shape with a slightly flared neck. It is richly adorned with polychrome floral and decorative motifs, crafted using the traditional cloisonné technique. Two finely detailed central scenes: -One depicts a green tripod incense burner, surrounded by colorful feathers, scrolls, and a bonsai-style plant, framed by golden borders and stylized patterns. -The other shows a blossoming plum branch, with red and orange petals delicately outlined in gold wire. The branch crosses the vase diagonally, evoking the poetry of Asian springtime. On the left, an oval medallion bordered by a golden geometric pattern reveals a miniature landscape: steep mountains, a turquoise lake, and a solitary green pine tree
