Antique & charming bronze entitled "Amour Charmeur". Work signed Kinsburger, representing a young child playing the pan flute. The child, with a delicate and expressive face, is sitting on a rock, a shoulder strap holding his quiver of bows and arrows. The sculpture, of great finesse of execution, highlights the softness of the features, the grace of the movement and the quality of the modeling. Nuanced brown patina. On the terrace, Kinsburger signature and plaque on the front bearing the inscription: "Amour Charmeur - by Kinsburger - Gold Medal at the Salon". 40 cm high. Bronze from the 19th century, very beautiful quality of chiseling and casting. Sensitive and poetic work, typical of the refined art of French sculpture of the end of the 19th century.
