Oil on canvas. A beautiful reproduction of Gauguin's painting, now held at the Musée d'Orsay in Paris. This copy was made in the second half of the 20th century, with a copy authorization code on the back of the canvas. Very beautiful carved and whitewashed wooden frame in the so-called "Montparnasse" style. Dimensions without frame: 38 cm x 46 cm Dimensions including frame: 57 cm x 64.5 cm The work is in perfect condition. Slight chips on the frame "Self-Portrait with Yellow Christ," or "Portrait of the Artist with Yellow Christ," is a painting that Paul Gauguin created in 1890-1891 in Pont-Aven. Gauguin depicts himself between his Yellow Christ, which he had painted the previous year, and a pottery piece bearing his effigy in a "grotesque" style. This painting is
