The man wears a dark blue velvet jacket with gold buttons and a white shirt with a lace jabot, in keeping with the Venetian fashion of the late 18th century. The face, framed by powdered hair gathered at the back, is rendered with a lively and spontaneous expression: the direct gaze and slight smile give the sitter a confident, unrestrained air. The modeling is soft but not idealized, revealing a realistic rather than celebratory intent. The warm light, coming from the left, shapes the face with soft chiaroscuro transitions and enhances the

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texture of the fabrics, underscoring the painter's skill in rendering matter and psychological characterization.
