Description

Italian School, early 19th century (after G.B.Sassoferrato), Madonna and Child, oil on paper applied to canvas, 38x28 cm. With frame: 57x46,5x4 cm. The painting depicts the Madonna and Child, inspired by the famous model by Giovanni Battista Salvi, known as Sassoferrato (1615-1685), a master of seventeenth-century devotional painting. The Virgin is depicted half-length, holding the Baby Jesus in her arms, in a calm and affectionate pose. The Madonna's face is idealized, with soft, melancholy eyes, her head covered by a light veil and wrapped in a blue cloak, while her robe is rendered in rosy tones. The Child appears tenderly resting on his mother's breast, with a lively gaze and a delicately modeled body. Condition: The painting is in good condition. We remain at your disposal.
