Very large box, marmot of the jewels of a cardinal-archbishop, primate of the Church or patriarch, part of the Sacred College, as indicated by its coat of arms, under cardinal's hat, the cord has 15 tassels, and the cross has a double crossbar. The wooden box is covered with a Havana-colored goat leather (morocco), struck on the lid, gold, silver, black and green with the great shield of the prelate, the borders of the box were gilded with the wheel. The interior, turquoise blue-green is lined with beautiful bottle green silk velvet, a tray for storing jewelry: Sapphire ring, pectoral cross, and others, Another tray, (missing) was to accommodate the crozier and the mitre. France or Italy, circa 1800-1830. Condition: very used, the prelate must have traveled a lot, rubbed on the edge and corners,
