The Hague, Chez Uttwerf & Van Dole, 1699; in-12, frontispiece and printed title page, LXXX + table of contents + 378 pp. + table of names and letters (approximately 40 pages), contemporary full calf binding, decorated spine with 5 raised bands, red morocco title piece, marbled edges. False mention of first volume. César-Pierre Richelet, grammarian, born in 1631 in Cheminon, died in 1698, was for some time regent at the college of Vitry-le-François, became a lawyer in Paris and left jurisprudence for literature. Well versed in the knowledge of ancient and modern languages, he published a French Dictionary.
