This humorfully circus scene executed by Austrian good listed painter, graphic artist and composer Erhard Amadeus-Dier (second name Amadeus), born in 1893 Vienna, died in 1969 Klosterneuburg-Weidling. He studied at the Staatsgewerbeschule Vienna, then at the Academy of Arts (by J. Jungwirth) and 1 year for music study. Since 1921-member of Viennese Art Union "Künstlerhaus". Travells : 1931-37 Switzerland, 1938 Prague, Spain und Italy. 1938-43 in Germany: 1939-42 als Chief-Designer by the Rosenthal-Porzellain manufacture in Berlin, nearby also as illustrator for different magazines Zss. (publisher Westermann; Velhagen & Klasing; Belvedere). Since 1945 worked in Austria again. 1946 Prof. und Prize of Austrian Nat.-Bank ; 1949 Golden honor medal of
