Plaster medallion representing a jazz band - 1950s Original plaster medallion (or tondo) sculpted in a modernist spirit, representing a jazz band in full improvisation. We can clearly distinguish the silhouettes of a double bass player, a trumpeter and a saxophonist, treated in strong relief, in a rhythmic and expressive composition. The work, typical of the 1950s, evokes the vitality of the post-war music scene and the influence of jazz in the visual arts.
