CHÂTEAU MOUTON ROTHSCHILD - 1er Grand Cru Classé, vintage 1956 Rare bottle of Château Mouton Rothschild, vintage 1956, Premier Grand Cru Classé of Pauillac. Labeled with the famous artistic visual characteristic of the house, here adorned with the work of Bernard Dufour. Bottled at the château, emblematic red capsule with embossed seal. A collector's wine, emblematic of Bordeaux elegance, this vintage, although born from a difficult year (historic frost in the spring of 1956), remains prized for its rarity and historical value. Provenance: capsule and label "Calvet", historic Bordeaux trading house.
