Hallmarks on the reverse: - Hallmark of the silversmiths Daniel Smith & Robert Sharp (DS/RS), active in London between 1763 and 1788. - Crowned leopard's head hallmark partially erased. - Two hallmarks largely erased and barely legible. - Swan import hallmark.
