Ilkirch-Graffenstaden and died on September 17, 1960 in Cannes. He received prestigious training, starting at the École des Arts Décoratifs in Strasbourg, then attended the Kunstakademie in Munich, and finally trained at the Beaux-Arts in Paris. After a few years in the French army, he returned to Alsace and taught drawing at the Lycée Kléber and the École d'Architecture in Strasbourg. He exhibited in Alsace in Colmar and
