Rare "Curiosity" and very beautiful lamp in bright blue earthenware nuanced in the shape of a large basin with four ribbed feet, open white enameled internally and punctuated with holes letting the light pass laterally in addition to the generous vertical beam; composed of four times 16 blown flowers on the front garnished with a clever extension of a blown glass tube in order to diffuse the light through the holes, a beautiful opulent and very decorative piece neat with perfect enameling and beautiful dimension, the very stable base decorated with a herringbone pattern in the mass forming a frieze above the powerful feet.
