All ends are superbly engraved with fruits, flowers, foliage, acanthus leaves, etc. The spoon and spade are beautifully openwork. The service comes in its retailer's case. Each piece is hallmarked: Minerva, 1st grade, before 1973 for 950/00 silver. Silversmith's mark: CB with a gaiter and a star for Charles Barrier, active from 1905 to 1923. Magnificent service flatware featuring a superb imperial decoration that is both rich and delicate. The goldsmith's work is of high quality, with dense cutlery for this type of
