Description

Pair of oval miniatures on ivory representing two children from the Restoration period. The first child wears a brown jacket opening at the front to reveal a white shirt decorated with a blue silk bow. His face is framed by large curls. This portrait stands out against a cloudy pink and blue background. The second child, in a garnet velvet suit and white lace collar, also stands out against a cloudy background. The face is more elongated and he also wears a hairstyle with large curls. Some small paint losses at the bottom left. The gilt bronze frames are topped with a ribbon and rose garlands motif. These miniatures are both protected by glass. We note a great quality of execution in small strokes. The children's eyes are lively with white highlights to accentuate the brightness of the pupils. These are probably two
