Adrien Simoneton was born in Paris in 1862 to Antoine Simoneton and Emmanuelle Ollive, creators of the Simoneton establishments, a world-renowned company in the textile sector, fire hoses, various filters etc. Holders of numerous patents and awards acquired in the major universal exhibitions. Adrien will prefer to choose a life as an artist, he will be a draftsman, engraver, cabinetmaker and above all a painter. Landscape painter he will paint the Bay of Naples, the Bay of Saint-Tropez, then at the
