In good condition just slight wear from use on the edge of the neck...The porcelain, for an important piece like this is quite fine, so it is of good quality...Some firing defects in lack of enamel...The theme is for the large cartouches, in similarities, are on the SAMURAI...On the small cartouches also in pairs the theme of birds and ducks in their nature...Even inside the neck, it is decorated...There are even on the neck of the
