He has often used natural materials such as wood and leather, and his designs have been widely recognized for their craftsmanship and durability. Tibergaard has received several awards for his work, including the Gold Medal from the Royal Danish Industrial Design Society. His designs are also featured in the permanent collections of several art and design museums, including the Museum of Modern Art in New York and the Museum of Decorative Arts in Copenhagen.
